Workload Prioritization Worksheet (Renewals, Classic, IRA): General – Agland and Beginning Farmer - Agland

Instructions:

The official Workload Prioritization Tool must be completed on Conservation Desktop. This worksheet is an optional version for planners to utilize that does not replace the necessity of completing the tool on the required business tools.

Prioritization is based on the highest priority land use between cropland and pasture as applicable, on the operation. For example, if crop is “high” priority but pasture “medium” priority, the entire application will be considered “high” priority. If farmstead is the only land use, the application will be considered “high” priority.
