

Big Horn Sulphur Cinquefoil Control TIP Amendment Proposal

Summary- The local interest in this TIP has proven to remain popular and consistent. In order to continue to address the need for sulphur cinquefoil treatment in Big Horn County, this amendment recommends extending this TIP an additional three years, adding Fiscal Years (FY) 2025-2027 and updating the budget accordingly. The project boundary will change to the county boundary and the practice list will stay the same. The existing (315) Herbaceous Weed Treatment and (528) Prescribed Grazing practices are listed on the Climate Smart Ag and Forestry list, and future applications may thus be considered for Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) funding.

Budget- In taking into account previously funded sulphur cinquefoil applications, the following budget is estimated for this TIP amendment.
