

PART 512 – CONSTRUCTION

SUBPART G – SAFETY

WA512.61 Personal Protective Equipment (PPF)

- (1) PPF requirements are located in GM 360 Part 420 Safety and Health Management Program and Washington State Supplements to the GM Policy.
- (2) NRCS Personnel shall use professional judgment regarding potential hazards and safety needs to mitigate construction site injuries. The use of steel toed boots, eye protection, hearing protection, shall be at the discretion of each employee. The following web link to OSHA’s construction safety page is provided:

- (3) Construction Personnel shall be reminded about construction site safety and their adherence with all pertinent OSHA regulations.

WA512.62 Training

- (1) All WA State Office engineering staff, Area engineering staff and area technicians shall complete OSHA safety training annually for construction site safety and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Training requirement will be sent statewide via State Bulletin that provides the minimum safety training requirements for fiscal year.
