As an NRCS engineering technician, you'll be involved in planning, design, and construction work.

You'll help with surveying the land, plotting survey information, and laying out construction measures. You'll gather data, make computations, and prepare maps and cross sections of profiles. You may serve as a construction inspector on a wide variety of projects.

Qualifications: Experience on a survey crew running levels and transits or on construction layout and inspection. Experience including technical work in: drafting, surveying, construction estimating, physical science, mathematics, aerospace, architecture, chemicals, electrical or mechanical systems, mining, petroleum, or nuclear systems.
