Application Assistance for Projects that Support Underserved Entities in Critical Conservation Areas

NRCS will offer assistance with completing proposal applications for projects that support underserved entities representing agricultural producers and communities in critical conservation areas (CCA), to address priority resource concerns identified by the Secretary. The purpose of this assistance is to increase the number of eligible partners in critical conservation areas applying for RCPP.

Eligibility

This service is available to the following:

A. Community-based organization, network, or coalition of community-based organizations that (i) has demonstrated experience in providing agricultural education or other agriculturally related services to socially disadvantaged farmers and ranchers and veteran farmers or ranchers; (ii) has provided to the <u>Secretary</u> documentary evidence of work with, and on behalf of, socially disadvantaged farmers or ranchers and veteran farmers or ranchers during the 3-year period preceding the submission of an application for assistance under this subsection; and (iii) does not engage in activities prohibited under U.S. Code, Title 26, Section 501 (c) (3). (section 501(c)(3) of title 26)

- B. 1890 institution or 1994 institution, including West Virginia State College,
- C. Indian tribal community college or an Alaska Native cooperative college,

D. Hispanic-Serving Institutions, any other institution of higher education that has demonstrated experience in providing agriculture education or other agriculturally related services to socially disadvantaged farmers and ranchers in a region,

E. Indian Tribe or a national tribal organization that has demonstrated experience in providing agriculture education or other agriculturally related services to socially disadvantaged farmers and ranchers in a region,

F. Organization or institution that received funding under subsection (a) before January 1, 1996, but only with respect to projects that the Secretary considers are similar to projects previously carried out by the organization or institution under such subsection.
