Final Plan-EA and FONSI Notice of Availability

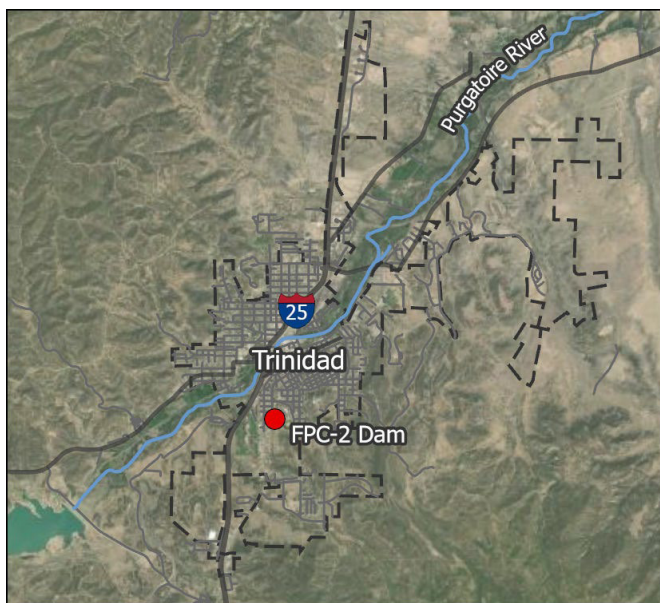
City of Trinidad, CO, announce the availability of the Final Supplemental Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment (Final Plan-EA) and the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the for the Fisher Peak Carbon Arroyo Watershed Dam FPC-2 Rehabilitation Project. The Project proposes to extend the life of the existing flood control dam that has protected homes and businesses in the Carbon Arroyo watershed since it was constructed in 1962. This project objective will be accomplished by making repairs to the dam's principal and auxiliary spillways and internal seepage control structures.

An evaluation of potential project alternatives and associated environmental impacts have been documented in the form of a Final Supplemental Plan-EA and the NRCS State Conservationist has issued a FONSI for the Preferred Alternative.
