



Notice of Prescribed Burn

What YOU Need to Know.



Details and Dates

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) in partnership with a private landowner will perform a prescribed burn on a complex of sites enrolled in the Wetlands Reserve Program in Klamath County, Oregon.

The exact date and time of the burn(s) will depend on weather conditions, but the burn(s) will take place sometime between:

Feb. 24 - March 31, 2025

Easement Site

Burn Area: 700 acres

Location: Approximately 1/2 mile west of OR 62 and 5 miles west of Chiloquin, OR.

Private residences are adjacent to the burn area.

Expectations

The burn(s) will be completed by professional prescribed burning teams and will be closely monitored by technical staff to ensure public safety.

Minimal smoke impact is expected.

Prescribed burning is an effective land management tool that provides multiple benefits to the land, including healthier soils, and improved habitat for wildlife.

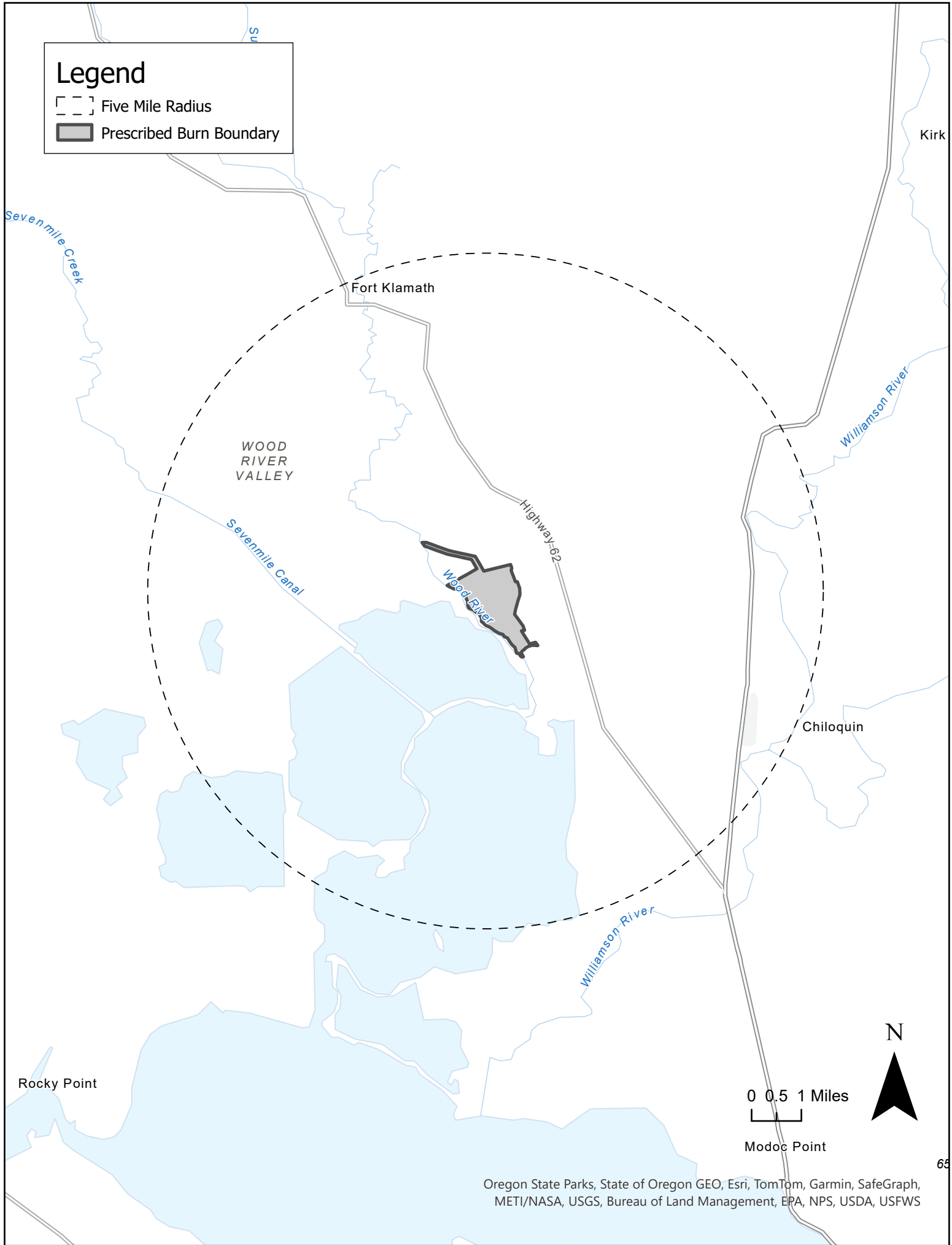
