April 14, 2025 - Moving Forward



Partnerships for Climate Smart Commodities reformed and overhauled into the Advancing Markets for Producers (AMP).

\$3 +Billion in 141 projects

Farmer First policy priorities to be reviewed:

- A minimum of 65% of federal funds must go to producers;
- Grant recipients must have enrolled at least one producer as of 12/31/2024; and
- Grant recipients must have made a payment to at least one producer as of 12/31/2024.

Conservation Stewardship Program

FY25 Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP)



MN CSP Funds (in Millions)







FY2025 Initial CSP (including IRA) Allocation: \$56.1M

- Organic-\$200,000
- CSP Classic \$33.6M
 - Farm Bill Funds: \$18.1M
 - IRA Funds: \$15.4M
- CSP Renewals-\$22.4M
 - Farm Bill Funds: \$12.1M
 - IRA Funds: \$10.3M
- Additional Funds Request In April 2025: \$12M (Farm Bill Funds)

March 10th-2025 Renewal application deadline November 15th –2025 Classic application deadline

- IRA Renewal-19

2025 CSP Renewal Obligations

- Farm Bill Renewal
 - 59 Contracts Obligated
 - \$9.4M Obligated
 - Contract Average: \$159,500
- IRA Renewals
 - 19 Contracts Obligated
 - \$1.7M Obligated
 - Contract average: \$88,200

2025 CSP Classic

CSP Classic Applications: 1,947

- Farm Bill Applications Ranked-865
 - Total Requested Funding: \$93M
 - Preapproved Applications: 256
 - Preapproved Application Estimate: \$19.6M
- IRA Ranked-Paused
 STOP
- CSP Classic Obligations (as of May 1, 2025)
 - Farm Bill Funds
 - 51 Contracts Obligated
 - \$4.5 M
 - Contract Average: \$ 86,224
 - IRA Renewals-Paused stop





2026 CSP Renewals

2021 Contracts Eligible for CSP Renewal Application-188

- Notifications mailed on or before April 18, 2025
- 2026 CSP Renewal Timeline
 - Deadline for application: June 6, 2025
 - Contract obligation deadline: December 12, 2025
 - Allocation not known





FY25 Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)











EQIP 2025

Received 3,936 EQIP applications

- General Farm Bill Funds: \$46 Million
 - Applications currently selected for funding: 478 applications
 - Contracts already funded: 443 contracts
- IRA EQIP: \$40.5 Million ^{STOP}
 - Applications selected for funding: 204 applications
 - Contracts already funded: 18 contracts

On track...

National Goals:



- Beginning Farmer or Rancher (BFR): 5% goal
 - ✓ Currently 15% contracts obligated to BFR (\$7M)
- Socially Disadvantaged (SD) producer: 5% goal
 - ✓ Currently at 7% obligations towards SD producers
- Livestock: 60% goal
 - ✓ Currently 30% obligated towards livestock related practices
- Wildlife: 10% goal
 - ✓ Currently 5% obligated towards wildlife practices

RCPP 2025 Delivery



- 2881 Trout Unlimited Driftless Area -Habitat for the Wild and Rare Phase (MN, WI)
- \$990,000 available for the project
- Dakota, Rice, Goodhue, Steele, Dodge, Olmstead, Wabasha, Winona, Mower, Fillmore and Houston counties



RCPP 2025 Delivery



- 2245 American Bird Conservancy (ABC) – Improving Forest Health for Wildlife Resources (MN, WI, MI)
- \$150,000 remaining for the project.
- Currently have 30 applications being assessed and ranked for this signup.
- There are 20 counties in the NE that are in the project area.



RCPP 2025 Delivery



- 2888 Minnesota Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts - One Watershed One Plan (MASWCD – 1W1P)
- Approximately \$1M remaining for the project.
- There were 4 Watersheds in FY25
 - Red Lake River: 8 preapproved for \$543,919
 - Lake Superior North: 8 preapproved for \$143,665
 - North Fork Crow: 8 preapproved for \$360,000
 - Root River: 0 applications



3053 -BWSR - Advancing Soil Health in MN Agriculture



- FY23 Award
- Alternative Funding Arrangement (AFA)
- \$25M RCPP to Producers
- \$25M BWSR Staff, Training and to producers

3494 – BWSR - AFA: Water Storage and Soil Water Management for Climate-Resilient, Healthy Watersheds

4210 - American Farmland Trust - Classic: Minnesota Farmland Protection Project: Bridging the Gap Between Landowners and Emerging Farmers

3513 - Morrison SWCD - Classic: Camp Ripley Sentinel Landscape - Phase 3

4320 - MDA (Renewed) - Classic : Expanding Innovative Irrigation Practices to Protect Groundwater





3494 - BWSR: Water Storage and Soil Water Management for Climate-Resilient, Healthy Watersheds

- AFA
- \$16M available for producers to create more water storage, to reduce flooding and improve water quality.





4210 – American Farmland Trust: Minnesota Farmland Protection Project: Bridging the Gap Between Landowners and Emerging Farmers

- Classic
- \$7.5M available for agricultural conservation easements. These easements will protect valuable agricultural acres that are at high risk of being converted to urban development, then transition this land into the hands of emerging farms and historically underserved producers.





3513 – Morrison SWCD: Camp Ripley Sentinel Landscape -Phase 3

- Classic
- \$10M available for producers
- 5 Eligible Counties: Cass, Crow Wing, Morrison and Todd.





4320 – MDA (Renewed) : Expanding Innovative Irrigation Practices to Protect Groundwater

- Classic
- Renewed from 2365 project.
- \$8.3M available for producers
- 5 more counties are eligible for the project; Clay, Wilkin, Wright, Anoka and Isanti

•ACEP WRE General: \$ 1,271,711

Expecting to fund 1 application for ~\$1,235,000

ACEP Stewardship: \$643,000

- •+\$250,000
- +\$1.7 million for 5 year burn contract
- Total: ~\$2.6 million

•ACEP IRA: \$1,085,821

 If funds get released it will be challenging to complete required due diligence

Monitoring Workload

Every easement must be monitored every year

25-50% of easements are monitored onsite every year

Partner Assistance:

- FY25 175 onsites to be completed by PF
- FY24 –150 onsites completed by PF
