Draft Plan-EA Notice of Availability



The United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) announce the availability of the Draft Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment (Plan-EA) for the Saratoga Springs Watershed in Utah County, Utah. The Plan-EA preferred alternative proposes improvements along two drainage channels to provide flood protection for the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah. Improvements include installing debris basins and improving drainage channels to safely attenuate and convey flood flows at Burnt/Lott Canyons and Clark Canyon. The improvements reduce flooding on approximately 2,005 acres of land downstream of Burnt/Lott Canyons and 872 acres of land downstream of Clark Canyon (see flood maps on reverse side).

An evaluation of potential project alternatives and associated environmental impacts have been documented in the form of a Draft Plan-EA. NRCS (lead federal agency) and the local sponsoring organization (City of Saratoga Springs), will hold a public open house to provide information about the proposed Project and Draft Plan-EA analysis, and to collect comments on the Draft Plan-EA.

NRCS invites you to submit comments anytime during the open comment period starting **August 25**, 2025, and ending on September 24, 2025.




