E666130Z	Increase on-site carbon storage	Utilize forest management techniques to increase on-site carbon storage, including uneven-aged management, longer rotations, leave-tree retention, snags and down woody debris, and soil organic material.
E666132Z	Crop tree management for mast production	Forest stand improvement using crop tree management techniques to increase mast production.
E666137Z1	Snags, den trees, and coarse woody debris for wildlife habitat	Create and retain snags, den trees, forest stand structural diversity, and coarse woody debris on the forest floor to provide cover/shelter for native wildlife species.
E612137Z	Tree/shrub planting for wildlife cover	Tree or shrub planting to enhance habitat for native wildlife. A minimum of five tree or shrub species will be used; they will be species that provide cover for identified wildlife species.
E666137Z2	Summer roosting habitat for native forest-dwelling bat species	Creates new potential roost trees within upland and riparian forests to achieve desired summer habitat for forest dwelling bat species.
