We are the federal agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture that works with private landowners to help protect their natural resources.

What We Do: Our employees work closely with partners to provide conservation technical assistance and financial assistance through the Farm Bill.

Services: Encourage/install a variety of conservation practices that

- control erosion,
- conserve water, and
- improve soil health.

Farm Bill Programs: The 2014 Farm Bill offers farmers and ranchers financial incentives to voluntarily conserve natural resources on privately owned farmland. Its conservation provisions help reduce erosion, protect streams and rivers, restore and establish fish and wildlife habitat, and improve air quality.

Careers in Conservation: NRCS has 90 employees throughout the Pacific Islands Area who work in a variety of fields. Many are soil conservationists and technicians but we also have soil scientists, agronomists, and engineers.
