

FY 2017 Screening Criteria Worksheet - RCPP/EQIP

Water Quality Improvement through the Implementation of Forestry Practices

A Screening Worksheet is required to be completed for each eligible application.

Instructions:

This screening worksheet must be completed for each eligible producer applying for EQIP assistance for the Water Quality Improvement through the Implementation of Forestry Practices project. Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis. High priority applications will not be batched but will be automatically considered for funding regardless of ranking score.

Completion of this worksheet and documentation does not constitute agreement to provide EQIP program benefits or approval of an EQIP contract. The original screening worksheet should be filed with the applicant case file or EQIP program file and the screening priority (High or Low) must be recorded in ProTracts. Upon request, a copy of any completed screening worksheet may be provided to the applicant.
