

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), in coordination with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, plans to perform prescribed burns on an easement site that is enrolled in the Wetland Reserve Program (WRP) in Yamhill County, Oregon. The exact date and time of the burn will vary based on the current weather conditions, but the anticipated time frame window is between:

**Aug. 1 through Nov. 30, 2017**



## Prescribed Burn

Size: 20 acres  
Location:  
2.2 miles northwest  
of Amity; 4.2 miles  
southwest of  
McMinnville; 22  
miles northwest  
from Salem/Keizer.

The burn will be completed by professional prescribed burning teams and will be closely monitored by technical staff to ensure public safety. Due to the nature of the fuels, minimal smoke impact is expected. Prescribed burning is an effective land management tool that provides multiple benefits to the land, including healthier soils and improved habitat for wildlife.
