

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), in coordination with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, plans to perform a prescribed burn on an easement site that is enrolled in the Wetland Reserve Program (WRP) in Linn County, Oregon. The exact date and time of the burn will vary based on the current weather conditions, but the anticipated time window is between:

**Sept. 1 through Oct. 30, 2017**

The burn will be completed by professional prescribed burning teams and will be closely monitored by technical staff to ensure public safety. Moderate smoke impact is expected. Prescribed burning is an effective land management tool that provides multiple benefits to the land, including healthier soils and improved habitat for wildlife.
