

**NRCS Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)

**A Screening Worksheet must be completed for each eligible EQIP application.**

Instructions: This worksheet must be completed for each producer eligible to apply for the EQIP Monarch Butterfly Habitat Development Project (MBHP). Applications are accepted on a continuous basis; however, an application period has been established for purposes of evaluation, ranking, and funding decisions. The goal of this screening tool is to ensure that conservation technical assistance and EQIP program benefits are managed efficiently to address priority conservation needs related to this national project.

Completion of this worksheet and documentation does not constitute agreement to provide EQIP program benefits nor approval of a program contract. The original screening worksheet should be filed with the applicant case file or EQIP program file and unless the application is determined to be ineligible, the screening priority (high, medium, and low) must be recorded in ProTracts. Upon request, a copy of the completed screening worksheet may be provided to the applicant.

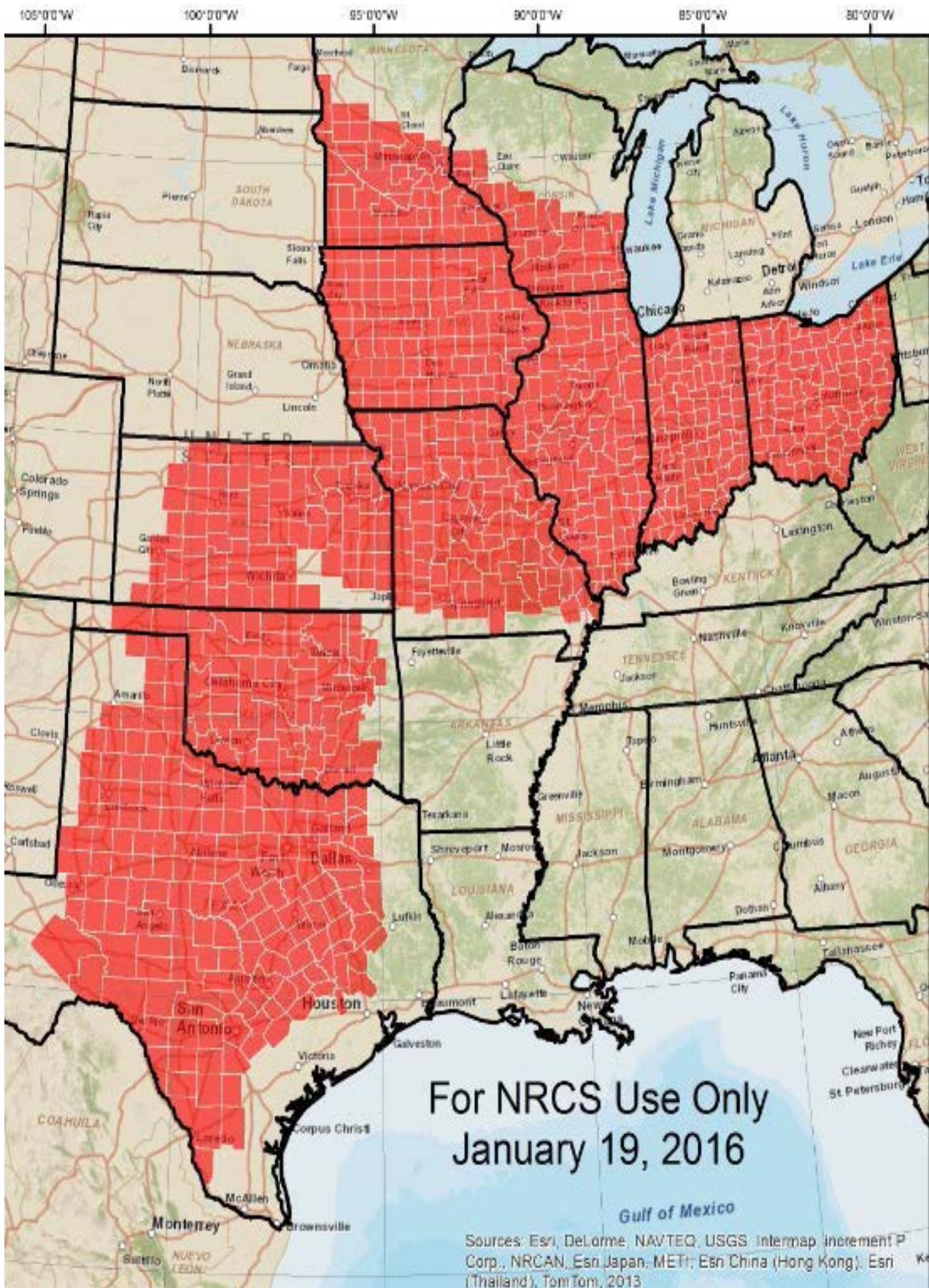
