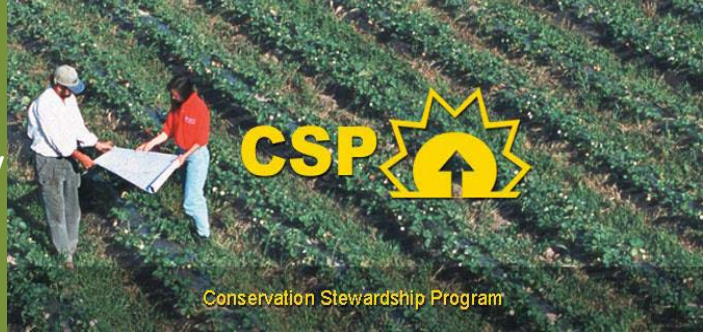




CSP – Landscape Conservation Initiative FY 2018
