Cropland- hazelnut update

Pheromone -IPM use of Ring placed in tree's

Spray in Targeted areas where moths are present

Current monitoring has been completed (lily)

Groundwater management-

SWCD- testing for fertilizer in historic ground water contamination sites.

Grazing lands / Pastureland

Air emissions from livestock facilities

Chickens, Goats, Cattle

(EPA-100lbs of N produced) 100-150 head of cows)

NRCS- Pasture management, pasture health (cross fencing, stock water facilities)

Ideas

Water to livestock- water catchment utilizing roof runoff gravity fed to tank

Forestland- tanks to refill fire trucks

Sacrifice areas- for livestock feeding/watering

Small properties with overgrazing (hobby farms) =
