Area of impact
2. Affected Environment:
 - Status of operation and maintenance of the dam
 - Sedimentation rates (planned, actual & future)
 - Sediment sampling techniques & testing
 - ARS publications (references)
 - Breach analysis (assumed parameters)
 - Hazard classification (NRCS and State agency)
3. Potential modes of dam failure (stability, hydrologic, seismic, seepage, material deterioration, etc.)
4. Consequences of dam failure (impacts of breach discharge) Population at risk
