



CREP: Helping Conservation Pay

Source of funds	Amount	Purpose
Cost Shares	75% cost-share as each practice is installed up to scheduled budget	Covers <u>most</u> of the cost of installing fence, trees, etc.
Incentive payments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. \$100 per acre to sign up 2. 40% to complete all practices 3. Special Incentive for “cumulative impact” areas—<i>neighbors add up!</i> 	Helps cover the cost of setting aside riparian pastures, bridges the gap between actual cost and cost share
Annual “rental” payments from FSA	<p>\$114 per acre on perennial streams</p> <p>\$102 per acre on intermittent</p> <p>\$171 per acre with</p>	Helps cover cost of lost feed on marginal low-production areas, fence and tree maintenance
