USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) in partnership with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will perform a prescribed burn on private land enrolled in the Wetland Reserve Program in Benton County, Oregon.

The exact date and time of the burns will depend on weather conditions, but the burns will take place sometime between:

Sept. 1 - Nov. 30, 2019

Sportsmens Hunting Club Easement Site

Size: 54 acres

Location: 12 miles south of Corvallis; 6 miles north of Alpine;
6.5 miles south of Philomath; 6 miles north of Monroe.


The burn will take place about 5.5 miles south of the Corvallis Airport, west of highway 99W. Minimal smoke may be visible from the highway.

The burns will be completed by professional prescribed burning teams and will be closely monitored by technical staff to ensure public safety. Minimal to moderate smoke impact is expected.

Prescribed burning is an effective land management tool that provides multiple benefits to the land, including healthier soils and improved habitat for wildlife.
