



Kansas Technical Sub-Committee Meeting Minutes
Source Water Protection Sub-committee
ZOOM Video Conference
March 26, 2020

Meeting with Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and the State Technical Committee (KTC) Source Water Protection Sub-committee opened at 9:00 a.m. with R. Dean Krehbiel, State Resource Conservationist for Kansas NRCS moderating.

- Sharonté E. Williams, Assistant State Conservationist for Programs, NRCS, opened with an explanation of what National Headquarters expects from each State when it comes to *Priority* practices and where our focus should be.
- Committee is asked to suggest up to 10 practices that deal with source water, though there will be some changes between this year and next. We now have the sideboards we did not previously have.

ZOOM Video Conferencing was used; the meeting was recorded and that recording has been posted to the NRCS [State Technical Committee](#) page. It includes the PowerPoint presentation visual as well.

The committee recommended the following practices to address source water protection:

- 580 – Streambank and Shoreline Protection
- 582 – Open Channel
- 584 – Channel Stabilization (doesn't appear in FOTG)
- 590 – Nutrient Management
- 657 – Wetland Restoration
- 658 – Wetland Creation
- 659 – Wetland Enhancement
- 449 – Irrigation Water Management
- 386 – Field Border
- 420 – Wildlife Habitat Establishment

It was also suggested that the state focus on practices that promote the removal of phosphorus. Dissolved P₂O₅ as a whole.
