DmE	HEL	Dekalb-Marrowbone-Latham complex, very rocky, 6 to 70 percent slopes
FbD	PHEL	Fairpoint and Bethesda soils, 0 to 20 percent slopes
FbE	PHEL	Fairpoint and Bethesda soils, 2 to 70 percent slopes
Gr	NHEL	Grigsby-Rowdy complex, frequently flooded
Ng	NHEL	Nolin-Grigsby complex, occasionally flooded
SgE	HEL	Shelocta-Gilpin-Hazleton complex, 20 to 70 percent slopes
SkE	HEL	Shelocta-Gilpin-Kimper complex, 20 to 70 percent slopes
W	NHEL	Water (<40 acres)
