Work in the Stream Channel

- 395 large woody debris (LWD) and rock placement
- 396 aquatic organism passage
- 578 stream crossing
- 643 beaver dam analog (BDA)
- 582 open channel
- 484 mulch and seeding



Riparian

- 395 stream habitat improvement & management
- 643 restoration of rare or declining natural communities
- 390 & 391 riparian herbaceous cover, riparian forest buffer
- 490 tree/shrub site preparation
- 612 tree/shrub establishment
- 314 & 315 brush management & herbaceous weed treatment
