

**Lees Creek
Fund Account Fact Sheet
Fiscal Year 2021**

Eligibility

The Lees Creek Fund Account is available to applicants with land in the Lees Creek Watershed (HU 05100101220300) located in Mason County. The objective of this focused conservation project is to install conservation practices which will improve riparian areas, manage nutrients transported to the watershed, reduce erosion and nutrients and pathogens entering the streams.

- Ranking Questions**
1. Are there planned land units adjacent to Lees Creek DOW impaired streams layer?
 2. Does the application include practices that will exclude livestock from Lees Creek?
 3. Are there planned land units in the application that are adjacent to Lees Creek stream order layer?
 4. Does the applicant have a current Ag Water Quality plan on file with Conservation District (updated in last 3 years)?
 5. EQIP-FCP schedule of operations will provide for implementation of all funded practices within two years or less.
