

**Ohio Valley  
Fund Account Fact Sheet  
Fiscal Year 2021**

**Eligibility**

The Ohio Valley Fund Account is for applicants with land located within one of the focal watersheds located in Daviess, McLean, Ohio and Hancock Counties. The objective of this focused conservation project is to reduce soil erosion and improve water quality within impaired watersheds throughout the Ohio Valley region.

- Ranking Questions**
1. Is the Erosion Index for the land included in this application equal to or greater than 8?
  2. Is the Erosion Index for the land included in this application less than 8?
  3. Does this application include planting a Cover Crop mix of 3 or more species?
  4. Does the application include planting a single species Cover Crop?
  5. Will the application implement practices that will solve gully erosion?
  6. Does the application include planting a Soil Health Cover Crop to increase organic matter?
