

**Eddy Creek-Erosion Reduction (ER)
 Fund Account Fact Sheet

Eligibility

The Eddy Creek Fund Account is for applicants with land in the Upper Eddy Creek Watersheds listed below which are in parts of Caldwell, Lyon and Trigg Counties. The objective of this focused conservation project is to address natural resource concerns of soil erosion and impaired water quality.

Ranking Questions

1. Does the planned land unit intersect a well head protection area or karst area as identified by DOW by at least 50%?
2. Select one answer below based on the location of the planned land units
 - 2a. Are the planned practices to be located adjacent to Eddy Creek?
 - 2b. Within 1,000 ft of Eddy Creek and its tributaries?
 - 2c. No direct access to secondary tributaries?
3. Planned practices will filter water entering stream with vegetative filter strip (riparian buffer).
4. Planned practices will reduce sheet and rill erosion on cropland by implementing cover crops.
