




CSP Pilot – Landscape Conservation Initiative FY 2015

Longleaf Pine Initiative (LLPI)

The CSP LLPI Pilot encourages forest producers to address priority resource concerns, such as degraded plant condition and inadequate habitat for fish and wildlife in a comprehensive manner by undertaking additional conservation activities; and improving, maintaining, and managing existing conservation activities.

- _____ PLT21- Forest stand improvement pre-treating vegetation and fuels preceding a prescribed fire, or, PLT28-Prescribed burning to promote and enhance conifer forests and maintain a healthy understory, or PLT31-Forest stand improvement, prescribed burning-short return interval; and ANM09-Grazing management to improve wildlife habitat
- _____ PLT21- Forest stand improvement pre-treating vegetation and fuels preceding a prescribed fire, or, PLT28-Prescribed burning to promote and enhance conifer forests and maintain a healthy understory, or PLT31-Forest stand improvement, prescribed burning-short return interval; and ANM55- Creation and retention of snags, den trees and coarse woody debris for wildlife habitat
- _____ ANM42 - Forest stand improvement for wildlife habitat and soil quality; and PLT26- Forest stand improvement to treat understory vegetation to minimize the risk of damaging wildfires

Bundles

- _____ BFO09 – Improve wildlife habitat, soil quality and forest health
 - Enhancement activities include: PLT15, PLT21, SQL13, WQL28 and either PLT23 or PLT24
- _____ BPI01 – Improves conifer forest health through prescribed burning and grazing management
 - Enhancement activities include: either PLT21, or PLT28, or PLT31, and ANM09, ANM11, ANM38, & PLT02
- _____ BPI02 – Improves conifer forest health through prescribed burning and forest stand management
 - Enhancement activities include: either PLT21 or PLT28 or PLT31 and four of the following five ANM27, ANM55, PLT15, PLT27 and WQL28
- _____ BPI03 – Improves forest health and wildlife habitat through forest stand management
 - Enhancement activities include: ANM42, PLT26, SQL13, and (either PLT23 or PLT24) and (either PLT15 or PLT18 or PLT29)
