SUBJECT: AGRICULTURAL PRICE STANDARDS, FY 1980, DRAFT TABLES

Purpose. To provide States with updated agricultural price information for use in water resource planning in accord with the Water Resources Council's (WRC) Principles and Standards.

Expiration Date. This bulletin expires March 1, 1980.

Background. Current normalized prices for water and related land resource planning have been updated by the Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service. The updated prices incorporate the most recent data available. The distributed lag procedure was used; the same procedure employed to develop the last set of normalized prices. These draft tables of prices should be used for planning activities until the WRC formally publishes the Agricultural Price Standards in early 1980. At that time, the Economics Division will make the usual distribution of these final standards.
