NRCS Assistance Available for Grizzly Bear Complex Fire Recovery

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) has funding now available to help farmers, ranchers and forest landowners recover from wildfire impacts on private agricultural and forest lands affected by the Grizzly Bear Complex Fire in Wallowa County, Oregon.

NRCS will rank and prioritize applications for funding in areas with the most extreme fire severity on private lands.

Conservation practices will target erosion control measures that will promote vegetative cover and replanting of burned forestlands.
