Biosecurity Preparedness and Response

MISSISSIPPI PROCEDURES CHECKLIST

Supplies listed are based on the requirements of the USDA-NRCS Biosecurity Preparedness and Response policy (GM_130_403_H, Amend. 15, June 2014) and Mississippi Bulletin No. 130-16-01.

Use the following checklist to ensure individuals follow the necessary procedures when visiting farms.

PROPER PROCEDURES

Document Site Specific Biosecurity Measures performed by Producer.

PRIOR TO ARRIVING ONSITE

Ensure That all **SUPPLIES** are available (use Mississippi Biosecurity Supply Checklist)

Identify **NEUTRAL PARKING ZONE** or other meeting place with producer.

DISINFECT VEHICLE with disinfectant. (Tires, Undercarriage, etc.)

Disinfect Auto before traveling through areas where other equipment/vehicles utilize.
(Vehicles that come into contact with litter)

NOTE: This Process/Step can be skipped if employee is meeting producer off site.

UPON ARRIVING ONSITE--(BEFORE ACCESSING /ENTERING SITE)

WASH HANDS with antibacterial gel/liquid antibacterial soap

Designate a **CLEAN AREA** and **DIRTY AREA** in your vehicle.

PUT ON FOOTWEAR, COVERALLS AND GLOVES prior to exiting vehicle.

Always Use: Nitrile gloves-Clean rubber boots or Disposable boots-Clean cloth coveralls or disposable Tyvek coveralls

DISINFECT ALL EQUIPMENT to be used during your visit. This should include survey equipment, shovels, soil augers, etc.

This step can be skipped if equipment has not been used at any other location since last time disinfected.

Leave disinfectant and cleaning equipment out to prevent additional contamination during the cleanup process prior to leaving the site.

DURING SITE VISIT

MINIMIZE CONTACT with any areas with litter
NO CONTACT with live animals or carcasses

AFTER SITE VISIT (PRIOR TO ENTERING VEIDCLE)

REMOVE ORGANIC MATTER From all equipment and clothing/footwear. Use brushes and water. Dry surfaces before disinfecting.

DISINFECT EQUIPMENT Place disinfected equipment **CLEAN AREA** of vehicle. Use clean brush and spray bottle to disinfectant. Use Footbath to clean shoes. Rinse and dry with paper towels. Dispose of paper towels in trash bag with other infected gear.

DISINFECT VEHICLE. Use Brush and spray bottle to disinfectant. Rinse well. Make sure to disinfect all parts of vehicle that come into contact with the ground or litter, especially tires and undercarriage.

REMOVE CLOTH COVERALLS - DISPOSABLE CLOTHING. Remove coveralls in a manner that they are inside out and place in dirty area of your vehicle. Cloth coveralls are not to be used again until washed. Remove disposable boots and gloves and place in trash bag.

DISINFECT RUBBER BOOTS. Use footbath, disinfectant, a clean brush, rinse and then dry with paper towels. Dispose of paper towel in trash bag.

LEAVE TRASH BAG with disposable clothing, footwear, and gloves on the facility if possible.

WASH HANDS

Use **antibacterial** gel, liquid or soap

Store BIOSECURITY SUPPLIES and EQUIPMENT

Always store equipment in clean areas
