Biosecurity Preparedness and Response

MISSISSIPPI PROCEDURE CHECKLIST

Supplies listed are based on the requirements of the USDA-NRCS Biosecurity Preparedness and Response policy (GM_130_403_H, Amend. 15, June 2014) and Mississippi Bulletin No. 130-16-01.

Use the following checklist to ensure individuals have the necessary supplies when visiting farms.

Field Office Biosecurity Supplies

NOTES / INFORMATION

Disinfectant (Virkon S)

10 pound container. Mix and dispose of according to label.

Disposable Coveralls

Sized appropriate for staff. Dispose of after each use.

Disposable/Rubber Boots

Disposable boots sized appropriate for staff. Dispose of after each use. Rubber boots should be free of buckles and with minimal folds for easy cleaning and shall be disinfected before and after each farm visit.

Nitrile Gloves

Sized appropriate for staff. Dispose of after each use.

Footbath Tub

For cleaning rubber boots and any equipment taken on farm. Clean organic matter from boots and equipment before use.

5 Gallon Bucket with Lid

Fill with clean water before each visit.

Pump-up Sprayer

(2 gal) for spraying equipment with disinfectant mixture.

Antibacterial Gel and/or Liquid
Antibacterial Soap

Minimum 60% alcohol for gel.

2 Long-handle Brushes

To be used for separation of clean and dirty equipment and supplies and for disposal of supplies.

Paper Towels

Make sure to dry equipment after pre-cleaning and before disinfectant.

Periodically inventory your biosecurity supplies. As biosecurity experience grows, the above information may change. Check the nearest Mississippi NRCS Office for updates.
