I attached a brochure about WDFW's sage-grouse recovery efforts, and a fact sheet about the WDFW sage-grouse Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances (CCAA). WDFW is conducting periodic status reviews for: snowy plovers, northern spotted owls, sage-grouse, and western gray squirrel.
