*315 – When using Chemical Ground-Heavy to address **Kudzu only**, practice financial assistance cap will be limited to \$3,200 BASE / \$3,800 HU. This cap does not apply to the State or National Initiatives. Run WIN-PST when applying this practice.

*338 – Prescribed Site Preparation must be planned with 394 and 490.

*394 – Practice financial assistance cap of \$2,400 BASE / \$4,300 HU per contract.

*410 – Impounded water cannot exceed one acre. For cropland, inlet control cannot be more than 0.5 ft. below lowest field row grade (not tailditch, water furrow, etc.). Embankment yardage is computed and included in the 410 Scenario Selector.

*460/484 – Limited to footprint of conservation structure

*666 – Practice financial assistance cap of \$5,200 BASE / \$6,200 HU

** \$10,000 BASE / \$12,000 HU limitation for Tree/Shrub Establishment (612) and/or Forest Site Preparation (490) per ownership per county for this resource concern.
This cap does not apply to longleaf tree planting.
