

**Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)  
Zone 1—Socially Disadvantaged  
Screening Criteria Worksheet – FY 2016**

A Screening Worksheet is required to be completed for each eligible EQIP application in the Zone 1 Socially Disadvantaged Funding Pool.

**Instructions:**  
This screening worksheet must be completed for each eligible producer applying for EQIP in the Zone 1 Socially Disadvantaged Local Funding Pool. Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis; however, cutoff dates are established for the purposes of ranking and funding allocation. The goal of this screening tool is to ensure that conservation technical assistance and EQIP program benefits are efficiently allocated to address the priorities of the Zone 1 Socially Disadvantaged Funding Pool.

Completion of this worksheet and documentation does not constitute agreement to provide EQIP program benefits or approval of an EQIP contract. The original screening worksheet should be filed with the applicant case file or EQIP program file and the screening priority (High, Medium, and Low) must be recorded in ProTracts. The applications will be placed in these screening priorities and funded until all monies have been distributed.

<b>Priority Determination for ProTracts – Select One:</b>	
<b>High Priority Category:</b> - The application addresses the resource concern of Soil Erosion. Planned practices will include (512) Forage and Biomass planting or (550) Range Planting.	<b>High Priority</b> Status in ProTracts
<b>Medium Priority Category:</b> - The application does not meet “High Priority Category” criteria, but does address resource concern of Inadequate Livestock Water. Planned practice will include (516) livestock pipeline, (642) water well, (533) pumping plant, (614) watering facility.	<b>Medium Priority</b> Status in ProTracts
<b>Low Priority Category:</b> - The application does not meet “High Priority Category” or “Medium Priority Category” criteria, but does address the resource concern of Excessive Plant Pest Pressure. Planned practices will include (338) Prescribed Burning or (314) Brush Management.	<b>Low Priority</b> Status in ProTracts
