

## How to get Vermont NRCS Soil Fact Sheets using the Vermont ANR Natural Resources Atlas – March 2016

Soil Fact Sheets are available for all soil map units in every county in Vermont. One way to get them is through the Vermont ANR Natural Resources Atlas.

Use **Quick Tools** to **Zoom to Town**, enter town name, then use the +/- zooming scale to zoom into the area in the town you want the Soil Fact Sheets for.

Under **Map Layers**, click the + next to **Geology** and then click on **Soils**.

A shaded soil map overlay will show up on the map.

Right-click on any soil map unit symbol you want a Soil Fact Sheet for and click on **What's Here**.

The Soil Fact Sheet link will show up in the left column – click to open, then you can print or save to your computer.

Continue to right-click on other soil map unit symbols if you want more than one Soil Fact Sheet.
