		Managed Haying - CRP <i>NON COST-SHARE</i> <u>Purpose:</u> To provide hay harvest during a limited time period on eligible Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) fields. For eligible practices see page 2. <u>Requirements:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants must request a modification to their CRP contract for haying CRP acreage from the Farm Service Agency (FSA). Participant may not hay CRP land until the modified CRP conservation plan of operation is approved. Participants may not hay and graze the same acreage. Haying cannot occur until 12 months after the vegetation is considered fully established. Participants can hay or graze the same CRP acreage only once every three years. Haying is not permitted on CRP cover types not listed as an eligible practice or CRP land within 120 feet of any stream or permanent waterbody. Refer to the attached conservation plan map for locations approved for haying. For eligible practices, see page 2. Producers can hay only one time between August 2nd and <u>September 15th</u>. Bales must be removed by <u>September 30th</u>. If cover fails as a result of haying, the CRP owner must re-establish the CRP cover at their own expense.
