3) Completed ACEP-ALE Ranking Form.	
4) Completed ACEP-ALE Application Data Sheet	
5) Hazardous materials Landowner Interview, Hazardous Materials Field Inspection Checklist and Landowner Disclosure Worksheet, Preliminary Certificate of Inspection and Possession. (Schedule with the field office.)	
6) Aerial Map, showing location including; Section, Township and Range, Roads, Acreage and Ingress/Egress to easement.	
7) Proof of ownership. (Ownership deed and supporting documentation such as Plat Map, tax records, etc.)	
8) Map of prime, unique or other important soils for the parcel including legend and acres.	
9) Map showing other protected parcels in relation to the parcel being offered.	
10) Evidence of how the parcel supports a state or local land protection program or documentation of Historical or Archaeological Resources for eligibility documentation under that criteria.	

11) Average Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) Certification (CCC-941) and HEL and Wetland Certification (AD-1026) must be current and on file with FSA.	
12) Statement regarding the level of threat from urban development for the parcel.	
13) Preliminary Title commitment including copies of all title exceptions (mortgages, liens, rights of way, easements, etc.)	
14) Copy of the pending offer for the parcel.
