General Notes:																	
The dollar amount noted for some practices is a payment cap. For management practices, the cap is by year and for structural or vegetative practices, the cap is by contract.																	
Ranking Pool Notes:																	
1. Payment caps will be 15% higher for historically underserved (HU) participants.																	
2. Payment caps in the Beginning Farmer and Socially Disadvantaged Farmer ranking pools have been increased by 15% and are noted with "HU".																	
3. Practices in the Livestock ranking pool are identified with a "C" or "P" to designate if the practice is applicable for Confinement Operations "C", Pasture Operations "P", or both "CP".																	
4. Illinois designated 6 high priority practices eligible for an increased payment in all ranking pools. The 6 practices are 554, 587, 590, 604, 605, and 656.																	
5. Illinois designated 10 source water protection practices for an increased payment rate in 2 ranking pools. The 10 practices are 329, 340, 391, 393, 554, 587, 590, 604, 605, and 656.
