Do you qualify as a Historically Underserved Producer?




USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service offers voluntary Farm Bill conservation programs that benefit agricultural producers and the environment.

Historically Underserved Groups are:

- Beginning Farmer or Rancher
- Limited Resource Farmer or Rancher
- Socially Disadvantaged Farmer or Rancher
- Veteran Farmer or Rancher

NRCS in Alaska considers any land that produces food and fiber, including subsistence hunting and gathering lands, as agricultural land for Farm Bill programs eligibility purposes, so people using subsistence lands for customary and traditional activities may consider themselves "farmers or ranchers".
