

Alaska EQIP Funding Pools

General	Available to address all NRCS resource concerns on all land uses.	
Beginning Farmer	Targeted to applicant's who meet the criteria of beginning farmer/rancher who self-certify their status when submitting an EQIP application. Available to address all NRCS resource concerns on all land uses.	
Socially Disadvantaged	Targeted to applicant's who meet the criteria of socially disadvantaged farmer/rancher who self-certify their status when submitting an EQIP application. Available to address all NRCS resource concerns on all land uses.	
Soil Health	Designed to provide financial assistance to agricultural operators who want to improve soil on their land.	
High Tunnel	Designed to assist producers to extend the growing season for high value crops in an environmentally safe manner. <i>This is the only subaccount with the (Code 325) High Tunnel Conservation Practice.</i>	
Wildlife	Designed to address wildlife resource concerns on all land uses.	
Forestry	Designed to address resource concerns on non-industrial private forestland.	
Organic	Designed to provide financial assistance opportunities for organic, transition to organic and organic-exempt producers to address natural resource concerns related to organic production as well as requirements related to the National Organic Program (NOP) requirements.	
On-Farm Energy	A national on-farm initiative specifically designed to provide financial assistance to address energy conservation through practice implementation and for development of an agricultural energy management plan (AgEMP).
